

Cookies

Doomoo website (“the Website”) uses cookies. A cookie is a small text file sent from a website and stored locally on the visitor’s computer or mobile device. They are used to help you navigate websites efficiently and perform certain functions. You can set your web browser to show a message before a website sends a cookie to your computer. You can then choose to accept or reject the cookie using the banner at the bottom of your page when you enter the website. You can always delete cookies from your web browser. You can also choose not to accept any cookies at all.

If you choose not to accept any cookies, you can still visit the Website, but certain functions on the Website will not work as intended. doomoo uses cookies to make things easier for you when visiting the Website, or to be able to monitor the number of visitors and their behaviors.

What type of cookies ?

There are different types of cookies.

1. Technical and functional cookies

The first type, persistent cookies, stores a cookie for a longer time on your computer and the cookies have an expiration date.

The other type is session cookies and are only used during your visit on the Website. Session cookies are deleted when you close your web browser. Session cookies are used to enhance your experience of the Website.

They allow you to :

- Navigate quickly and efficiently between the different sections within the website and to help you return to previous pages;
- Adapt the presentation of the sites to the display preferences of your device by memorizing them (e.g. location, navigation data, etc.);

2. Audience measurement cookies (statistics)

These cookies, issued by us or by our service provider - Google Analytics, make it possible to measure the audience of the various contents and sections of our sites in order to evaluate and better organize them.

These cookies also make it possible, if necessary, to detect navigation problems and consequently to improve the ergonomics of our services.

These cookies only produce anonymous statistics and traffic volumes to the exclusion of any individual information.

3. Tracking pixel

The tracking pixel allows platforms (usually social networks facebook, ...) to qualify the audience of our site by relating it to their own information. These pixels give the platforms the possibility, if you are simultaneously connected to them, to follow your navigation on our site and to establish a profile of your interests.

This data is governed by the general terms and conditions of the platforms in question. They are anonymous and do not allow you to be identified as a person

How long do we keep these cookies?

Persistent cookies are stored on your terminal for up to 13 months.

How to manage cookies depending on the browser you are using

Essential cookies do not require your consent.

For other cookies, we ask for your consent before placing them on your terminal. Furthermore you can give your consent or decline cookies at any time by :

Configuring your browser to accept or decline cookies.

However, please note that if you disable cookies in your browser, you will not be able to take full advantage of the features of our Site. For example, you will not be able to take advantage of personalization features of our Website.

Please also note that you must configure each browser on your different devices (tablets, smartphones, computers). There are different ways to configure browsers. We recommend that you refer to the "Help" section of the browser you are using to understand how to configure it and exercise your options.
